WORKSHOP TITLE	Teen healthy-Go! How to build an effective partnership between young people and professionals in training programs
RATIONALE	<p>Building a real partnership between adolescents and health professionals will improve adolescent medicine. Before this skills building workshop, a group of young Indian and European people supported by professionals will meet 3 days in Paris, France, in July 2017, discussing three issues :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • How to build an effective partnership between young people and professionals to transmit knowledge and skills? • How to create a peer education project on health subjects which has the same success like Pokemon-Go[®] at its start? • How to use teensource digital as a tool of peer education? <p>This workshop will use this first step and its results to provide to participants the experimentation of a partnership with young people based on peer education.</p>

Training objectives	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Advocate and facilitate young people’s participation in social change and in programs concerning their own health. 2. Define peer education and review its interest and application. 3. Acquire a “know-how” and “know-how-to-be” for partnership work with young people. 4. Experiment the partnership with young people by building together a “digital age” peer education project.
